

Level 3 (QCF)

Diploma in Commissioning Procurement and Contracting for Care Services

The aim of this qualification is to guide and assess development of knowledge and skills relating to Commissioning, Procurement and Contracting, and to confirm competence in these areas where appropriate. Learners who will undertake the Level 3 Diploma in Commissioning, Procurement and Contracting for Care Services will wholly or partly be engaged in roles in social care and children's & young people's sectors in England, Wales and N Ireland. The role may or may not be specified in the job title, and it may encompass joint commissioning with health bodies.

Typical units:

- Engage in personal development in health, social care or children and young people's settings
- Work effectively within a commissioning organisation
- Purposes and principles of independent advocacy
- Introduction to personalisation in social care
- Understand the context of supporting individuals with learning disabilities
- Understand physical disability
- Support decision making and problem solving

Assessment

A range of assessment methodologies will be agreed to meet learner and organisational preferences and requirements to effectively and efficiently meet the learning outcomes of the qualification.

Course Duration

12 months
