

Level 5 (QCF)

Diploma in Commissioning Procurement and Contracting for Care Services

The aim of this qualification is to guide and assess development of knowledge and skills relating to Commissioning, Procurement and Contracting, and to confirm competence in these areas where appropriate. Learners who will undertake the Level 5 Diploma in Commissioning, Procurement and Contracting for Care Services will wholly or partly be engaged in roles in social care and children's & young people's sectors in England, Wales and N Ireland. The role may or may not be specified in the job title, and it may encompass joint commissioning with health bodies.

Typical units:

- Maintain systems that promote communication
- Champion equality, diversity and inclusion
- Principles of safeguarding children, young people and vulnerable adults
- Introduce improvements in commissioning care services
- Share knowledge and good practice
- Promote the development of self-directed support when commissioning services
- Develop evidence-based policies and strategies for commissioning services

Assessment

A range of assessment methodologies will be agreed to meet learner and organisational preferences/requirements to effectively and efficiently meet the learning outcomes of the qualification and regulatory arrangements for the Qualifications and Credit Framework.

Course Duration

12 months
